



Glasgow City HSCP Health Improvement Community Food Grants Scheme 2025-26 Application Guidance

Thank you for your interest in applying to our Community Grants Scheme 2025-26. Please read the information in the guidance carefully and complete the enclosed Application Form.

Background

The NHSGG&C Public Health Nutrition Team invited ideas and allocated a sum of money that areas across the board could apply for (Scottish Government funding). Glasgow City HSCP Health Improvement Food Group were successful in securing a sum of money to provide a Community Food Grants Scheme across the 3 Localities within the City, these being the North East, North West and South communities, with each locality being allocated £5,600.

Application Process

The Glasgow City Health Improvement Food Group has agreed that applications made to this Community Grants Scheme should meet the priorities of at least one of the six themes that form the Glasgow City Food Plan: [Glasgow City Food Plan – Good Food For All](#) Those themes are; **Community Food; Food Poverty-Fair Food for All; Children & Young People; Environment & Food Waste; Food Economy; Food Procurement & Catering**; however, with the nature of the fund, we fully anticipate that most applications will fall within the first three listed themes.

We are inviting applications to be awarded up to a maximum of £1,000 per locality. If your application is to deliver work City wide, and across the three localities, then please indicate this on the application form.

Please note, awarded projects are required to implement their projects by the 31st of March 2026 and submit their evaluation no later than 17th April 2026.

Once you have completed and checked your Application Form, please return it to ggc.northeasthealthimprovementteam.admin@nhs.scot by 5pm on Monday 5th January 2026, after which your application will go before a scoring panel. If you have any queries or require clarification prior to returning your form, please email the same address and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

There will be three options open to the scoring panel, these being Full Award; Partial Award; and No Award. Irrespective of the decision, you will be contacted, and feedback on your application will be available if desired.

If your application is successful, we will contact you by email by Friday 16th January 2026 to arrange payment.
